WHERE DOES THE PROFIT GO? Answer: Into your Student's Account

When a student participates in any OMBA program (Band/Choir/Theater) and its fundraisers, an individual student account is created for them. Any profit from any of the above fundraisers is put in their student account. That money stays in that student's individual account until they graduate. During their participation in the OMBA Programs, this money can be used to pay for the Band/Choir Trip (usually in May) or the Theater Trip (usually in Spring).

At no time can this money be refunded to a student. Money fundraised under the OMBA NON-Profit status cannot be used for NON OMBA (Ex. Senior Trip) or personal purposes.

If a student leaves the program with money in their account, that money will remain there until they graduate.

WHAT HAPPENS TO MONEY IN A STUDENT'S ACCOUNT WHEN THEY GRADUATE?

The OMBA will transfer the funds **ONLY** to a sibling of the current student.

If the student does not have a sibling coming to Overbrook, the money is returned to the General Fund of the OMBA to cover operating expenses of the organization.

SOME OF THESE FUNDRAISERS ARE EXTREMELY PROFITABLE AND GO A LONG WAY TOWARD HELPING TO PAY FOR THESE TRIPS. IF YOU PARTICIPATE, REMEMBER TO USE YOUR STUDENT ACCOUNT MONEY FIRST TO MAKE YOUR PAYMENTS BECAUSE IT CANNOT BE REFUNDED TO YOU.
